RULES OF Silent & Live AUCTIONS

SILENT AUCTION If you wish to bid on an item, write your bidder number on the bid sheet. The first bid MUST meet the "Starting Bid" stated on the bid sheet. You may bid on each item as often as you like, but you must increase your bid by the minimum raise. You may also bid as far over the minimum raise as you would like. At the CLOSE of each silent auction table, the person who placed the last bid on the bid sheet will be deemed the purchaser of the item. AN AUCTION TEAM member will resolve any disputes.

LIVE AUCTION The Auctioneers will auction off items listed on the back of this page. If you desire to bid on a live item, remain seated and hold up your bidder card. Auctioneer will determine the highest bidder. Full payment of all the cumulative items must be made the evening of the event. Cash, check (payable to SMS PFC), Visa, Mastercard, AMEX or Discover are accepted.

GENERAL RULES All sales are final. If you are buying an item as a group, only one check or payment is to be submitted to the cashier for payment. All auction items are sold as is.
