Treasurer Christina Flint

 We fell short of our fundraising goals as we weren't allowed to be at the Registration Walkthrough, as that is where PFC makes the majority of the fundraising money.

Context:

- Our Walkthrough Goal: \$25k
- Raised: \$6,209.07 or 25% to goal.

Option 1: CUT \$15k

 This doesn't 100% make up the difference, but we might still be able to pull in a bit more from folks who have said they would donate later, and we do have some in reserve.

Option 2: Cut \$7.6k, add online auction

 This requires that we add in an auction with a projected income of ~\$7,400.

Option 3: Not Cuts, Add Live Auction

■ In this option, we don't cut anything but commit to an in-person auction with a projected income of ~\$15,200.

• Motion: We move to make cuts to the PFC 2023-2024 Budget as Proposed in Option 2.

New Teachers Budget & Hospitality Cuts:

- The hospitality cuts also included the Alhambra water.
